STUDIO 223, 329, & 344 RESIDENCY

June 1, 2019 - September 30, 2020

Studios: Studio 223 is located on the second floor and studios 329 and 344 are located on the third floor. Rent is \$15.92 per square foot per year and increases by 3% each October.

- Studio 223 is 440.7 square feet. It has large east facing windows facing Union St providing natural light.
- Studio 329 is 315.37 square feet. It is located near the Alexandria Archaeology Museum and has large east facing windows providing natural light.
- Studio 344 is 225.93 square feet. It is located on the north end of the building. It has two large windows that look into the hallway.

Residency Dates: June 1, 2019 - September 30, 2020

Application Due: Application live on March 27, 2019. Due by April 21, 2019 by 11:59pm

Notification: Applicants will be notified of selection by May 10, 2019

Eligibility: Open to all TFAA members (or artist who were selected by a TFAA jury process), artists who held a lease between October 2016 to today, Visiting Artists Program artists selected between 2017 and 2019, or artists selected for the Post-Grad studio at the Torpedo Factory Art Center. Applicants may apply individually for the studio or in a group to share the studio.

Requirements: Selected artists will be required to sign a lease and abide by the Torpedo Factory Art Center Rules and Procedures for tenants as well as be open on Friday night Art Center programming (Late Shift) at least 7 times during the residency.

Selection based on:

1. Ability to describe artwork
2. Background: Professional background and time spent at the Torpedo Factory Art Center
3. Ability to work well in communal space

Application consisting of:

1. 3 images (that will not be scored)
2. Short written statements:
 - a. process statement (less than 200 words)
 - b. artist statement (less than 200 words)
 - c. interest in studio statement (less than 200 words)
3. Resume or CV
4. Letter of recommendation describing ability to work well with others

Evaluators: Three total, consisting of at least one

1. Art educator



2. Gallery or museum specialist
